## Youth fights for life after car crash

A YOUTH is fighting for his life after a crash in a car believed to have been stolen from Wellingborough.

Police say they believe the car involved in the collision in Northampton early on Saturday was stolen from Wellingborough.

Two youngsters were injured in the crash, which left one of them with what police described as "potentially life-threatening" injuries.

Officers are appealing for information about the youths' movements after it emerged they were linked with a robbery on a pizza delivery driver, which happened about 10 minutes before the car they were in crashed.

A police spokesman said the robbery happened at 12am on Saturday, in Salisbury Street, Semilong, when a pizza delivery driver was assaulted and his wallet was stolen.

When police arrived at the scene, witnesses pointed out a silver Renault Laguna with potential offenders in in nearby Stanley Street.

The officers set off to find the car but saw it collide with a parked and unattended car in Spencer Bridge Road. The crash happened at about 12.10am.

A force spokesman said: "In the fullness of time police will be question these two men in connection with the robbery on the delivery driver and the theft of the walley and assault of the driver and the theft of the stolen car.

"In the meantime, anyone who has information about the incident in Stanley Street or collision in Spencer Bridge Road is asked to call police on 08453 700 700."

The identities of the pair are not known but police described them as "young adult males". Both sustained serious injuries and were taken to Northampton General Hospital.

The road was reopened at 5am.
